POLICY ON HOSTEL RATES FOR OTHER THAN NORMAL BOOKINGS

Reviewed July 2017 by the Trustees

1. Staying in the flat long-term is not an option.
2. The Family Room is not available for anyone seeking reduced rates unless it is being used as a dormitory
3. Room 1 is preferred because of its isolation and less disturbance for those who get up at unsocial hours. (2am, for example).
4. External speakers at SBBO meetings can be offered up to two nights free as part of their expenses
5. All people who stay must pay with the exceptions of the following categories –
 - a) Speakers, at organiser's discretion,
 - b) two week placements or more for those who act as Assistant Wardens
 - c) those who can provide a specific study to be agreed with Council
6. Reduced rates are available to anyone who contributes to a regular, beneficial activity where this activity requires an over-night stay, e.g. moth-ing, maize ringing, ringing on a non-covered day where traveling distance is prohibitive, mammal trappers – any other beneficial activity will be referred to Council, e.g. an expert in spiders or beetles.
7. £5 is the reduced rate for the activities in item 6.
