<i>Buddleja davidii</i>	Butterfly-bush	A few plants on perimeter banks
<i>Carex hirta</i>	Hairy Sedge	Frequent with Toad rush
<i>Chenopodium album</i>	Fat-hen	
<i>Cirsium arvense</i>	Creeping Thistle	
<i>Cirsium vulgare</i>	Spear Thistle	
<i>Crassula helmsii</i>	New Zealand Pigmyweed	Occasional at present on drawdown zone and as an aquatic
<i>Crepis capillaris</i>	Smooth Hawk's-beard	
<i>Dactylorhiza praetermissa</i>	Southern Marsh-orchid	Occasional with most around the 'old hide'
<i>Epilobium hirsutum</i>	Great Willowherb	
<i>Epilobium tetragonum</i>	Square-stalked Willowherb	Occasional
<i>Equisetum arvense</i>	Field Horsetail	
<i>Eupatorium cannabinum</i>	Hemp-agrimony	
<i>Geranium dissectum</i>	Cut-leaved Crane's-bill	
<i>Heracleum sphondylium</i>	Hogweed	
<i>Hirschfeldia incana</i>	Hoary Mustard	
<i>Holcus lanatus</i>	Yorkshire-fog	
<i>Hydrocotyle vulgaris</i>	Marsh Pennywort	Occasional – drawdown area

<i>Matricaria chamomilla</i>	Scented Mayweed

Schedonorus arundinaceus	Tall Fescue	
Senecio erucifolius	Hoary Ragwort
