The sessions, suitable for 7 to 12 year olds, start at 10am, finish at 2pm and only cost £3. Members need to bring their own lunch, a change of clothes for wet weather and sturdy walking shoes.

We track animals in the fields and woods, go scavenging on the beach and use our great binoculars to identify some of the many species of birds at Sandwich Bay.
